Glaze Practice and Experimentation with Mini Pots

Objectives/Requirements

- Create 10 mini pots using the pinch technique or by using a mold
- Each pot must have an attached foot
 - The foot must be a minimum of ½ inch high
 - There must be a clean line or divider between foot and pot this will help you determine how much a piece runs)
 - The entire foot must be free from glaze (this also will help you determine how much a piece runs)
- The pot should be no bigger than 3 inches in any direction
- All pots must have your full name visible on the foot and be numbered 1-10
- You must accurately fill out your glaze chart

Grading: 40 points total

- 10 points for an accurate and complete glaze chart (1 point per pot)
- 10 points for each completed and glazed pot (1 point per pot)
- 10 points for a ½ inch foot, properly attached, on every pot (1 point per pot)
- 10 points for a visible full name on every pot. Must be visible after glaze fire

Additional deductions

- Unfired pots will receive no credit
- Pots that explode/break (because of thickness or lack of wedging) will receive not credit.
