## Soft Slab Mug







## Objectives:

- Create a functional mug using the soft slab technique
- In order to be functional, your mug must be glazed
- Your mug must be a 'regular mug' size (12-16 oz)
- Your mug must include a handle which is slipped, scored, and blended (and should stay attached during drying and firing)
- Use one decorative technique on the body of the mug (applique, carve, impress, sgraffito)
- Your mug must have a thin lip in order to be able to drink comfortably

## Grading: 15 points

- 2 points: google form in answered and answers explained
- 3 points: body of mug is made from soft slab, is a 'standard' mug size, seams are blended, time and effort are apparent
- 2 points: mug is glazed and did not stick to kiln shelf
- 3 points: handle is scored, slipped, and blended, time and effort are apparent
- 3 points: Decorative technique is used on body of mug and time and effort are apparent
- 2 points: rim/lip of mug is thinned out and smoothed with no jagged or sharp edges
