Stop Motion Group Project

Video length/picture requirements:

- Create a stop motion video that is at least 60 second long
- Use a minimum of 6 frames per second (6 photos = 1 second of footage)

Story/Plot

- Create a plot with storyboard to describe what happens in your video

Character requirements:

- Create a minimum of 2 sculptural characters (oil based clay or mixed media)
- Each character must have a minimum of 2 moving parts

Background requirements:

- You must have a minimum of 1 background for your movie
- A background image is required (paint, draw, construct, etc.)
- Your background must have a minimum of 2 three dimensional objects that must also move (for example, cotton for clouds moving in sky, paper airplane flying through sky, ball characters are interacting with, etc)

Editing requirement:

- Use any software you like to create your stop motion video
- Export your movie to a file type that will play on a pc (avi, mov, mp4, etc.)
- Consider adding music and credits (not required)
- Recommended Free software:
Stop Motion Studio (for apple and android)

Grading Criteria (25 points total)

5 points: video is at least 60 seconds long (with 6fps)

2 points: 2 sculptural characters were made

4 points: each sculptural character has at least 2 moving parts

2 points: at least one background was constructed

2 points: background has a least 2 3D objects

2 points: answer and explain reflection questions when turning in

3 points: cohesive storyline

5 points: time and effort are apparent, classroom time was used wisely

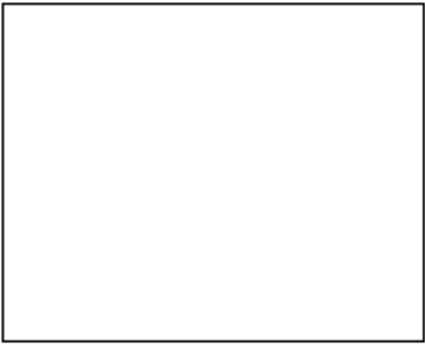

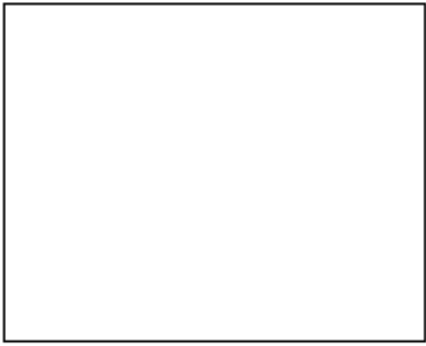

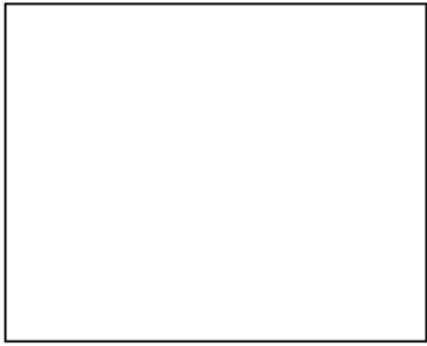
